## **Ten Tips to make Standout Movies**

- Auto settings can be great for the inexperienced, but you will get a better result using manual control
- 2. Avoid using the zoom wherever possible
- 3. Use a tripod or find an object to brace against while holding the camera



- 4. Record sound for every shot, and preferable with a microphone that is held separately from the camera
- 5. Ensure the person speaking can be heard without straining your ears
- 6. When framing people shots be conscious of headroom
- 7. Remember that everything that happens, from acting to editing must have a reason
- 8. Understand the story you are telling and prepare a rough storyboard to help you decide the shots you need
- 9. It's hard to tell a story that is compelling without conflict
- 10. Always remember your audience. Who will see your finished film and what will they be looking for
